



The Integrated Prehospital Care System



Initial First Aid

First aid is started by Members of public; saving lives in the first few minutes of an emergency situation.



Emergency Hotline

The 111 hotline helps people get immediate care. The centre coordinates all ambulances and medical aircraft.



First Responders

Police and firefighters that are trained first responders that are able to give advanced first aid immediately at the scene, and render care until an ambulance arrives.



Ambulance

The staff on every ambulance are trained and equipped to give basic life support and initial emergency stabilisation.



Advanced Care

Paramedics and nurses provide additional support to ambulance crews giving advanced life support to stabilise the ill or injured at the scene.



Hospital Care

Ambulances take patients to the most appropriate health facility for their needs. Sometimes Ambulance workers can give definitive treatment and referral at the scene, avoiding the need for hospitalisation.



W HEART SAFE



AEDs are recommended at workplaces, hotels and airports. Many businesses are choosing to be 'heart safe' by having a defibrillator (AED) available at their worksite.

If a person is in cardiac arrest, collapsed and not breathing their heart may need a controlled electrical shock to try make it beat properly again.

An automated external defibrillator (AED) is a fully automated medical device that detects if a person is in cardiac arrest by analysing the heart's activity. The AED gives instructions too. If the AED determines a person needs a shock to save their life, the machine will talk to you and then deliver the shock. If no shock is needed, the AED will give you instructions which you should follow.

AEDs are very safe and easy to use. A person can be taught to use an AED during one of our first aid courses. To have most life-saving effect, AEDs should be easy to reach, accessible at all times and ideally be within two minutes walking distance from wherever people work or play.

For each minute, that a person is left untreated in cardiac arrest, the chance of survival drops by about ten percent. Even if they are alerted immediately, emergency teams take some time to arrive. For this reason, automated external defibrillators have been placed in locations where they are easily accessible, such as airports, gyms and hotels.










